Who They Are: The Collingwood General and Marine Hospital (CGMH) serves the Georgian Triangle, which encompasses Collingwood, Wasaga Beach, Clearview Township and The Blue Mountains. The Georgian Triangle is one of the top four-season resort areas in Ontario, and one of the fastest growing areas in Canada. The CGMH is a 68-bed facility serving more than 60,000 permanent residents and 3.5 Million annual visitors to the area.

What They Do: CGMH is an acute care hospital providing emergency care, diagnostic services including lab, imaging and cardio respiratory therapy, as well as two inpatient units (medicine and surgery). In addition, CGMH also provides care in specialty areas including obstetrics, orthopedics, intensive care, and surgery, as well as providing outpatient care including dialysis and a wide range of clinics including mental health and rehabilitation services. They pride themselves on fast, accurate diagnosis and exceptional care delivered by expert, caring medical staff and supported by a caring community.

Why They Need Your Support: CGMH is working to overcome the challenges created by an old and undersized facility, growing patient volumes, and isolation from urban centers. They need to renovate their emergency room, to provide each patient with privacy and personalized care in traumatic moments. They need to repair basic infrastructure, like elevators and fire alarm panels. They need to update and upgrade surgical equipment and technology, to give their staff the tools that will help them do the best job possible, and develop medical technology to best serve their large patient base with their limited resources. Despite what you might believe, the government does not fully fund healthcare in Ontario. At the CGMH over 90% of all medical equipment & technology is funded through community support.
